- The Riders Rally is only open to motorcyclists and their passengers. **No Cars.**
- All types of motorcycles authorised by road traffic regulations may participate.
- The event is a point-to-point navigation ride.
- Participation is at the discretion of the organiser, whose decisions are final.
- Entries may be made at the 1<sup>st</sup> Checkpoint. Times Friday July 29<sup>th</sup> 4pm till 10pm or Saturday July 30<sup>th</sup> 8am till 10am. The fee is €40 per driver & €20 for pillions. The benefits of the fee include: Route cards for each stage of the navigation ride; 3 nights' camping; Shower rooms; 3 evenings' entertainment; awards, badges, souvenirs.
- Only participants who complete the route in accordance with these regulations are eligible for badges, souvenirs, awards and entry to the awards function at the Final Checkpoint.
- Awards**, based on information on the entry forms, will be made as follows:

• <b>Largest Club</b> (number of motorcycles; if clubs tied number of pillions, then mileage declared at start counts)	
• <b>Long Distance</b> - Individual	• <b>Youngest Driver</b> - Individual
• <b>Smallest Motorcycle</b> - Individual	• <b>Oldest Motorcycle</b> - Individual
• <b>Special Award</b>	• <b>Eamon Waldron Memorial Trophy</b>

**8. Tips for a good ride:**

• Expect the unexpected - Follow the Rules
• Being stopped for speeding wastes time, earns penalty points & costs YOU money
• Avoid travelling in large groups - Pinpoint navigation, not high speed!
• Arrive early! - Leave early! - Relax evenings! - Avoid night-time travel!
• Start Friday & be at the 2 <sup>nd</sup> CP Friday night, or early on Saturday morning
• Break camp & Start early each morning - Don't waste time at or between CPs
• <b>Procedure at Checkpoints:</b>
• 1) Safely park motorcycle - 2) Check-in - have route-card recorded
• 3) Read the next Route onto map or into your GPS
• 4) Or take 15 mins timeout for food & relax
• 5) Check fuel & bike and GO
• <b>Advise DMTC by phone or at a CP if delayed, need a short-cut or need to leave the Rally</b>

- 9. Protection of the Environment** - Rider Conduct - Individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users. - Ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding. - Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines. - Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency. - Noise annoys. Use a standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level. - Use only routes that are legally available to motorcyclists. - Ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding in groups. - Respect nature by not travelling on routes that risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery. - Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently. - Encourage fuel efficiency and space economy by riding motorcycles instead of driving automobiles.
